HISTORY



The Kumho Tyre V8 Touring Car Series was originally created in 2008 as part of the Shannons Australian Motor Racing Nationals.

It was created to provide a category of racing for Supercars no longer used in the main Supercars Championship or Super2 Series.

It held its first round at Mallala that year with just four cars but has grown rapidly over the following years to the point where it has become an unofficial third tier of V8 Supercar competition.

The cars race with a control Kumho tyre, 7500 rev limit and have quickly built a following - particularly with plenty of teams presenting their cars in 'retro' liveries.
