CHAPTER 1

1) EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- a) **Event Title:** 2017 Australian Muscle Car Masters
- b) **Date:** Saturday 28th & Sunday 29th October 2017
- c) **Venue:** Sydney Motor Sport Park, Ferrers Road, Eastern Creek NSW. The Gardner 3.93km will be used.

2) ORGANISATION AND STATUS

- a) The event shall be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations published by CAMS, the regulations for 5th Category – Historic Cars, relevant Series Sporting Regulations as approved by CAMS, these supplementary regulations and any further regulations and instructions to competitors that may be issued.
- b) The event shall be a **National Other** race meeting.

4) CIRCUIT DETAILS – Gardner Circuit

- a) **Length:** 3.93 km
b) **Direction:** Anti - Clockwise
c) **Track Density:** The maximum number of starters permitted in any race will be in accordance with CAMS guidelines as follows.
Group N (47), Group C & A (47), Kumho V8 Touring Cars (47)
Sports Sedans (38)

6) EVENTS & DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

Races will be conducted for vehicles complying with regulations for the following categories as outlined in the 2017 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and relevant 2017 series or group regulations;

- Group N Historic Touring Cars & Invited appropriate vehicles,
- Round 4 2017 Heritage Touring Car Series (Group C & A)
- Round 5 2017 Kumho Tyre V8 Touring Car Series
- Round 5 2017 National Sports Sedan Series.

Practice and qualifying will take place on Saturday 28th October before 2.30pm. Number of laps for races will be notified in the Further Regulations.

All automobiles participating in Group N must be in possession of a CAMS 5th Category Historic Log book. If a Certificate of Description has been issued for a Group N automobile, it must be presented upon request throughout the meeting.

All automobiles participating in Group N may be requested by the Organiser to display a PAYCE windscreen banner on the front windscreen.

Subject to article 1.8 of the General Regulations for 5th Category Historic Cars, a temporary permit to compete is an acceptable alternative to the possession of a Historic Certificate of Description or a Historic Vehicle Log Book.

All automobiles participating in the 2017 Kumho Tyre V8 Touring Car Series, must comply with the relevant Sporting and Technical Regulations as issued by CAMS.

DEMONSTRATIONS on a Closed Track (MASTER BLAST)

- A display of vehicles aimed at demonstrating the vehicles performance.
- No passengers are permitted during demonstrations.
- A demonstration may be over a number of laps or for a period of time (to be advised in the event further regulations.)
- Drivers must wear apparel (including helmet) as per the relevant competition and Schedule D of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- Passing of demonstration vehicles by others is permitted where marshals have shown the blue flag to the vehicle being passed.
- Timing is not allowed.
- Presentations based on performance or aimed at presenting the image of a race are not permitted.
- Participants in these sessions who do not currently hold a CAMS Competition licence must register on the day at the Secretary's office for a CAMS L1 licence at a cost of \$25.00 (incl GST).

The organiser reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59.

7) LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

Each Competitor must hold a CAMS Competition Licence unless they comply with (a) or (b) below. Each Driver must hold a minimum of a CAMS Provisional Clubman Circuit competition licence unless otherwise noted against a particular event or specified in the Sporting Regulations for the relevant Championship / Cup / Series / Trophy/etc or;

- (a) Hold a Motor Sport New Zealand competition licence, and a Tasman Visa valid for the event.
- (b) Hold a minimum of the highest grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN together with an authorisation issued by that ASN for the event; Such Drivers and Competitors will be ineligible to score points in any Championship / Cup / Series / Trophy/etc connected with the event;

Participants in demonstrations who do not hold a CAMS Competition Licence, must register on the day at the Secretary's office for a CAMS L1 licence at a cost of \$25.00 (incl GST).

8) AUTOMATIC TIMING

- a) The organisers utilise an automatic timing system that requires all automobiles to be fitted with a Data 1 transmitter. Competitors must provide the transmitter. Transmitters are available from Dorian Industries, 6/29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing VIC 3029.

9) PRIVATE PRACTICE AVAILABILITY

- a) Sydney Motor Sport Park is available for private practice on Friday 27th of October 2017 for CAMS L2S licence holders and higher.

10) CREDENTIALS

All race competitors will receive 4 competitor passes with each entry. Demonstration drivers will receive 2 competitor passes each. Transporter / Work Vehicle / Race Car passes and competitor tickets can be collected at Gate A from 6pm Thursday 26th October 2017.

All competitors should enter Sydney Motor Sport Park via Gate A off Ferrers Road. Proceed through Gate A and down to the tunnel entrance where car passes and people passes will be checked. Then continue through the tunnel to your designated space in the paddock or the support paddock.

No refunds will be given if drivers and pit crew have to pay at the gates because they have not received their passes from the competitor.

11) FUEL

Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

RaceFuels are the circuit official fuel supplier and can be contacted via email or phone racefuels.com.au, Office: (03) 9706 5233. Mobile: 0419 511 517

Leaded racing fuel, pump unleaded and commercial E85 fuel are available via bowser at all times from the circuit. The bowsers accept all credit cards. Unleaded racing fuel is available via pre order only.

The maximum amount of fuel to be stored in each garage is 250 litres. Refuelling is not allowed in pit lane or in pit garages whilst participating in a race.

12) INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

13) PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

14) PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

15) PRIZES/AWARDS

First 3 placegetters in the main race for each category will be presented with a trophy. Series awards and points (where applicable) will be awarded in accordance with the relevant sporting regulations.

16) TARGETED SCRUTINY

There will be targeted scrutiny, with times to be advised in Further Regulations.

The Chief Scrutineer, or his representative for the event, will determine which vehicles will be audited and those competitors will be advised of a time in which the audit will occur at event documentation scrutiny.
