#### 1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

The event shall be known as Round 6, 2017 Shannons Australian Motor Racing Nationals to be held on the 8 to 10 September, 2017, at the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit, Phillip Island, Victoria.

#### 2 EVENT ORGANISATION AND STATUS

The event shall be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations published by CAMS, the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit Standing Race Regulations (Issue 04/2014), relevant Category Sporting and/or Technical regulations as approved by CAMS, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and Bulletins that may be issued by either the Series or Meeting Organisers. The event shall be a National Race Meeting.

- o Australian Production Cars – 4-hour race
- o Porsche GT3 Challenge – 3 x 20 min races
- o Australian GT Trophy – 2 x 50 min races.

#### 6 **ENTRIES**

**Opening Date: On issue of the Series Entry Form**

**Closing Date: August 25th**

Entry Fee per category will be as negotiated via Series Management and Category Managers. All entries are to be submitted as per agreements between each category and Series Management, using the Series Entry Form issued at the start of the series. Each Competitor must hold a CAMS Competition Licence unless they comply with a or b below. Each Driver must hold a minimum of a CAMS Provisional Circuit competition licence unless noted otherwise against a particular event or in the Sporting Regulations for the relevant Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy/etc. or

a. hold a Motor Sport New Zealand competition licence and Tasman Visa valid for the event; or  
b. hold a minimum of the highest grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN together with an authorisation issued by that ASN for the event. Such Drivers and Competitors:

i. will be ineligible to score points in any Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy/etc connected with the event; and  
ii. must receive an authorisation to compete from the ASN that issued their licence and CAMS prior to the event;

The Organiser confirms that the circuit to be used for this event holds the necessary CAMS National Track licence for each of the events nominated in these Supplementary Regulations. The promoter reserves the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR83.

#### 7 **GENERAL**

1. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.
2. The promoter reserves the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR59.
3. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to each Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au).
4. Timing will be by electronic means and the Chief Timekeeper is deemed a Judge of Fact with regard to timing.
5. Awards will be as per Series Regulations.
6. Specific detail of events will be included in Further Regulations or the Schedule.
7. Judges of Fact will be detailed in Further Regulations or at the circuit and posted on the Notice Board.
8. As Targeted Scrutiny is to be used at this Meeting, there are no structured scrutiny times listed. Document Check details will be in the schedule with Further Regulations.
9. Entries will be accepted for each category up to the track density for that category, and thereafter, accepted as reserves under conditions to be discussed at time of acceptance.

#### 8 **ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

#### 9 **3 DAY MEETING**

All three days from Friday to Sunday are official days of the Meeting and are covered by the Series Entry Form.

- 10**      **ADMISSION TO CIRCUIT**  
Access to the circuit will be available on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 under conditions to be distributed before the Meeting by the individual Category Managers
- Otherwise, for the Meeting days, access to the circuit is strictly from 0700 hours on 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, and 10<sup>th</sup> May unless otherwise arranged through the Category Managers and/or announced in Further Regulations. Each competitor will receive 1 (one) Tender Vehicle Pass along with 8 competitor passes per vehicle entered. The Tender Vehicle Pass will provide access close to the category garage area and other team vehicles must be parked in parking areas at the rear of the paddock.  
Extra weekend passes may be pre purchased from the Secretary of the Meeting at a cost of \$25.00.per ticket.
